**Discussion for Action Taken Report based on last 12<sup>th</sup> meeting:**

**ACTION TAKEN REPORT BASED ON RECOMMENDATIONS OF LAST 12<sup>TH</sup> SAC MEETING  
HELD ON 28<sup>TH</sup> MARCH, 2016**

2	To gear up promotion of bio fertilizer & bio agent, verimi-compost use etc.	Training programmes and awareness camps have been conducted for promoting the use of bio fertilizer & bio agent, vermi-compost. Motivational programmes on production of bio fertilizer & bio agent, verimi-compost have been conducted for FPOs/Farmers Clubs/SHGs.
3	KVK should try to establish Implements and Machinery Hub (Paddy Reaper, Cono Weeder, Drum Seeder, Thresher, Tractor, Power Tiller, etc) for Custom Hiring services.	KVK has already implemented paddy production and machinery hubs excluding paddy transplanter and combined harvester which are to be purchased soon.
4	Introduction of Soyabean crop in operational areas of KVK.	Though our on station trial on Soyabean crop, we learnt that there is scope to cultivate this crop on the upland areas of red and lateritic soil during kharif season and on medium land in Rabi Season. In the coming season the KVK will promote this practice in the farmers fields.
5	Popularization of seed treatment as well as assurance of critical inputs supply to the farming community.	It has been popularizing through trainings, FLDs and OFTs and also KVK has been supplying critical inputs from its Agro Service Centers, Satellite centers, farmers clubs, FPOs, SHGs etc
6	Exposure visit for farmers to be arranged	Exposure visit is a continual programme of KVK.
7	Emphasis to be given on publication of extension literature, Leaflets etc on modern agri practices, farm machinery & soil water management	Two books on modern techniques of cultivation of different feed as well as horticultural crops, four booklets, five leaflets have been published.
8	Emphasis to be given on soil test & treatment in order to maintain soil health	KVK has been tested soil samples of FLD and OFT farmers and others samples are being tested as per FIGs interests.

**Presentation of KVK's Progress Report (2016 -2017) and Action Plan for 2017 – 2018 :**

Dr. A.K.Maiti, Programme Coordinator, SBKVK and Member-Secretary, SAC presented the Progress Report (2016 – 2017) and Action Plan for 2017 - 2018 in front of house, which have been discussed in details in step by step, based on technological & technical aspect and has been appreciated by the house only adding few valuable suggestions by the hon'ble committee members attending in the meeting. Mainly, the economic features for the benefit of the farmers are preferred in noting down the suggestions. The perfect and ideal proposals are as follows:

- Mr. Sumit Kr. Chakraborty, Programme Executive, AIR, Kolkata, suggested that SBKVK may provide their success stories/ case studies/innovations for broadcasting through AIR.
- Ms. Suparna Chakraborty, Sub-divisional Horticulture Officer, Jhargram suggested that promotion and production of Cashew nut be followed by value addition programme especially, extraction of Cashew apple juice and Cashew nut by mobilizing the SHGs.
- Mr. Anjan Kr. Ghosal, Asstt. Agril. Marketing Officer, Jhargram, suggested that SBKVK should intervene to aware the farmers to avail the Kisan Mandis to sell their produce and to establish FPOs for backward and forward linkages with the market intelligence system.
- Dr. Mini Poduwal, RRS, BCKV, Jhargram appreciated the activities and sub-activities of SBKVK and suggested the following points as-  
Emphasis on mixed cropping system as Climate resilient Agriculture  
Development of Documentary film on Technology Assessment and Refinement.  
Emphasis on promotion and production of locale specific spices as well as organizing interface scientific/extension workers meetings to share the different agriculture and allied technology and its mode of operation.  
Crop museum needs to be developed in the SBKVK campus.
- Mr. Chandra Sekhar Hansda, FEO, Jamboni Block appreciated the KISAN SMS facilities being provided by national KVK Portal and expressed his desires to collaborate with SBKVK's programmes with the State level programmes to reach the maximum numbers of beneficiaries. He also suggested polythene lining and culture of indigenous magur to be practiced in small seasonal ponds. He also stressed on the availability of quality fish seeds and its scientific management practices.
- Mr. Kalyan Chandra Besra, ADA (S.M.), Jhargram opined on popularization of need based Agri. Machinery and equipments as well as emphasis be given on enhancing the water irrigation efficiency by micro-irrigation system and water shed development activities.
- Mrs. Sibani Baskey, Progressive Farm Women, Kenduasuli demanded for working shed in order to articulate know-how and entrepreneurship through KVK mandates. Mrs. Panmoni Saren, Progressive Farm Women, Tunkasole expressed her satisfaction for continued support of SBKVK as and when required. Whereas, Mr. B Bera opined the need of marketing facilities for selling farmers produce.
- Lastly, P.C, SBKVK proposed the reconstitution of SAC farmer and farmwoman members and house empowered PC, SBKVK for doing the needful.
